




Mac And Cheese And The Personal Space Invaders by Jolene Gutierrez - \$17.99 Lauren Pick




Sia Martinez and the Moonlight Beginning of **Everything by Raquel Vasquez Gillard**

Stamped by Jason Reynolds and Dr. Ibram X. Kendi \$18.99


Marc Pick Written for young people but important for all people, Stamped is an engaging and eye-opening history of racist ideas.






Network Effect by Martha Wells - \$26.99




Eye Sea - \$13.99
